Staffing Update

School Improvement Plan: Update

1.All stakeholders will continue to focus on curriculum development; contributing to the school rationale with a focus on the four contexts of learning.

Further support the needs of all learners through whole staff professional development on 'Attention Autism'.

- Impact to date has been positive with pupils building up attention & communication skills. Mrs Palmer is incorporating this approach to other aspects of the day e.g. phonics & interdisciplinary learning.
- 2. Provide high quality learning & teaching experiences in writing through use of learning intentions and success criteria. Talking and listening opportunities to be used as a vehicle to raise attainment in writing.
 - Mrs Simpson, our Literacy Co-ordinator is leading on this at tonight's CAT with a focus on model texts to engage learners.

3. Further develop Play based learning pedagogy at Early level and introduce play based principles to First & Second level.

Pupil progress and skills progression will be tracked and monitored through play experiences.

- Skills are tracked and monitored in ELC and in most classes using Skills framework. We will share with you more information and floor books to demonstrate the skills focused on at the next Parent Council meeting.
- School & ELC: Increased opportunities for high quality teaching & assessment in STEM.

 All resources have now been audited and our next priority is to purchase resources in line with SLC Science/System planning. We are working with SLC STEM leads on 31st January to further develop our Science/STEM planning across ELC & school.

4. Equity:

Provide targeted support in Numeracy with identified individuals and groups.

 4 teachers are embarking on Maths Recovery professional learning to provide targeted support in Numeracy with identified individuals and groups and to provide a firm foundation of maths knowledge.
