What's your attendance?



Above 95%

WELL DONE!

High attendance leads to improved and high achievement which means greater success.



95% or less

SLIGHT CONCERN

This is the same as missing 9 school days over the session: nearly 2 weeks!



90% or less

CONCERNING

This is the same as missing 19 school days over the session: almost 4 weeks!



85% or less

RISK OF UNDERACHIEVING

This is the same as missing 27 school days over the session: just less than 6 weeks!



80% or less

SEVERE RISK OF UNDERACHIEVING

This is the same as missing 36 school days over the session: just less than 8 weeks!



At Carstairs Junction Primary School we value excellent attendance and recognise the connection between regular attendance at school and the attainment and achievement of our children and young people.

We want to make sure our children receive the support they need to attend school and engage in their learning.
